

20-21 Vision Health Research Network Virtual Meetings Instructions

Deadline for Abstract Submission: November 6 2020

- Each student is encouraged to present his work. Each presenter has to register before filling out the "Submission" section on the "Fourwaves" website.
- <u>Between November 16 and 20</u>, we will inform by email the selected presenters of the date chosen for their **oral** or **poster presentation**.
- There is a total of 6 oral presentations and 25 poster presentations per day.

IMPORTANT: We cannot guarantee the selected type of presentation and the date.

Instructions for oral presentations

- We will use a **single Zoom link for all** presentations (welcome, plenary speaker, and the 6 oral presentations). This link will be send by email.
- On the day of the meeting, you will be invited to share your screen (in full-screen format) so that all attendees can see your presentation.
- We strongly suggest that you turn on your camera during your presentation.
- Your presentation should not exceed **8 minutes**. A time period of **2 minutes** will be dedicated to audience questions, even if the presentation is not finished.
- o You will be automatically penalized by the jury if you surplus the time.
- For confidentiality reasons, sessions will not be recorded.
- See also "**NOTE**" in the next section.

Instructions for posters or « Interactive Virtual Poster Platform »

- For the first meeting (December 4th), you must submit your poster by Tuesday, December 1st, at 8:00 AM. For all other meetings, you must send your poster before Tuesday preceding the meeting. A reminder will be sent.
- To do this, you must connect to "Fourwaves" and modify your submission form. In the subsection "**Presentation Submission**", you can upload your poster.
 - **POSTER** (image format = .gif, .png, .jpeg, .jpg), maximum size: 30 MB
- As the event is virtual, there are no specific requirements for the actual size of your poster. However, you must respect the maximum download capacity.
- Please schedule a 3-minutes presentation.
- You must be available throughout the "Session: Poster Presentation".
- During the entire period, there is no schedule. Attendees (including evaluators) will be invited to connect with you during this session. They will have access to your poster by clicking on your unique "Fourwaves" link (see "Program"). You will receive a notification.

NOTE: <u>All half-day presenters</u> (oral and poster presentations) can be contacted during this period as each of you has an **unique** "Fourwaves" link. We ask the presenters of the oral presentations to be available during this time as well as they may also be contacted. However, they will not be evaluated during this period.

Instructions for the attendee

NB: These instructions are also available in the "Presentation info" tab on the Fourwaves website.

Accessibility

To access all the features of the "Fourwaves" site, the attendee must log in by clicking on "Sign in" in the event menu (email and password). Only attendees will be able to access the abstracts and interact with the presenters.

Before the meeting

- **Before the meeting**, you are invited to consult the students' projects. You can consult the list or search by keywords.
- You will be able to access all the abstracts submitted so far by clicking on the "Abstracts" tab. This page will display the list of all student abstracts (oral and poster presentations).
